Dear Parents/Carers,

**Re: Pupil Testing Plan for Friday 03 September and Week Beginning Monday 06 September**

We hope you have had a restful and pleasant summer holiday. In line with government guidelines, we will be testing pupils on their return to school in order to limit the possibility of Covid outbreaks within the school setting. Therefore, we will be staggering the opening of school to allow for this to take place.

Pupils are to arrive at school for the following times on the following days. They will enter school through the Harrytown Hall entrance where they will be greeted by a member of staff. Pupils need to arrive and put a face mask on before they enter the building.

They will be directed where to go and what to do from this point onwards. Whilst the test usually only takes about 5 - 6 minutes to administer, pupils will need to register etc, so it is likely that they will be in school for about 20 – 30 minutes.

Pupils will exit the school building through the front main doors of school. They must leave the premises immediately and go home (except Year 7 pupils who will remain in school). They will then return to school the following school day for face-to-face lessons (providing a negative test result is received). We will only contact you if your child has a positive test result.

You only need to contact us (via the contact us form on the school website) if:

- you originally gave consent but now do not wish your child to be tested.
- You did not give consent originally, but now wish your child to be tested.

A second test will be conducted within 3-5 days of the first test and then pupils will be given home testing kits to continue testing twice a week at home. These should take place on Sunday and Wednesday each week until further notice.
